

Directions to Lubitz Farm

If you are flying... Be sure to keep an eye out for other aircraft. It's a "see and be seen" situation! Proper circuit procedures are important, especially in high traffic areas around airstrips. Bring your own tie downs and two-stroke oil. We can supply auto gasoline, but have no aviation fuel. Be sure to carry the proper documents for you aircraft (C of A, C of R, insurance, pilot permit/license, medical, etc). Make sure the data plate matches the documents.

The grass runway is 1980 ft. long and 75 ft wide with clear approaches. Runway heading is 08-26. Latitude: 43deg 18.3'; longitude: 80deg 32.9' . We are about 11 air miles SW of the Waterloo Regional Airport, about 20 air miles ESE of Stratford Airport and about 20 air miles NNE of Brantford Airport. Look for two yellow buildings with white roofs, one with a black roof and a silver colored arch building. The non-standard wind indicator is located on top of the white roofed building south of the runway. A second windsock will be in the field north of the runway. Field elevation is 1000 feet ASL, circuits are left-hand and, for ultralights, 500 feet AGL (because we are under Class E controlled airspace with a 700 foot floor); for conventional aircraft, 1000 feet AGL. Details are also in the Flying Farmers Ontario Air Strip charts under LUBITZ, BRIGHT. In the map below, Bright Aviation is at the Lubitz Farm.

If you are driving ... from the EAST... take the 401 west to exit #268 - Plattsville and Ayr. At the light, turn left and follow Cedar Creek Rd (regional road 97) Watch for UPAC signs at Blenheim Rd. (Perry's Corners) and follow them. If you arrive before the signs are up, continue on to Washington where you will turn left towards Drumbo. At the next corner, Township Road 12, turn left. Drive two miles down this gravel road to an iron bridge. On the left just before the bridge there is a white plastic pail with a green lid that is the mailbox. Turn left into the lane and park along the side. The 911-identifier number is 907289.

... from the WEST... take the 401 east to exit 250, Drumbo. At the stop, turn right and follow the road into Drumbo. At the four way stop in the middle of town, turn left toward Washington. Go over the freeway, then a river, to Township Road 12. Turn right onto the gravel road and go two miles to an iron bridge. On the left just before the bridge there is a white plastic pail with a green lid that is the mailbox. Turn left into the lane and park along the side. The 911-identifier number is 907289

... from the SOUTH... take the 403 west past Brantford to the exit for Brant Country Road 25. At the stop, turn right and go to the T intersection. Go left and then take the first right onto County Road 3. Follow it through Princeton to Drumbo. Continue straight through the four way stop in Drumbo towards Washington, but you won't get to Washington. At Township Road 12, a gravel road, turn right and go two miles to an iron bridge. On the left, just before the bridge there is a white plastic pail with a green lid that is the mailbox. Turn left into the lane and park along the side. The 911-identifier number is 907289

... from the NORTH... from highways 7 and 8, take the Regional Road 12 or New Dundee exit. Drive south to New Dundee. Go through town, down and up the hill to the T intersection. Turn right and then take the first left at the bottom of the hill onto Oxford Road 43. Follow this road to the stop sign, which is County Road 8. Cross this road and at the next corner, Township Road 12, turn right. Follow this gravel road about one mile to an iron bridge. Just as you come off the bridge, on the right you'll see a white plastic pail with a green lid that is the mailbox. Turn right into the lane and park along the side. The 911-identifier number is 90728
